**RATE ORDER REGARDING RATES FOR BASIC SERVICE AND EQUIPMENT
AND INSTALLATION OF COMCAST CABLEVISION OF THE DISTRICT, LLC
FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 2012 THROUGH
DECEMBER 31, 2012**

WHEREAS, the Office of Cable Television of the District of Columbia, formerly known as the Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications (the "Office") became certified to regulate basic cable service rates and associated charges as of October 1, 1993, and has followed applicable regulations prescribed by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") for the regulation of the basic service tier (the "FCC Rules" as such rules have been amended from time to time);

WHEREAS, since 1994 the Office has issued rate orders with respect to the rates that Comcast Cablevision of the District, LLC (the "Company") and its predecessors may charge for basic service, equipment, and installation;

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2011, the Company submitted an FCC Form 1240 and an FCC Form 1205, (the FCC Form 1240 and the FCC Form 1205 to be referred to hereinafter as the "Rate Filings"), to the Office to update rates charged for basic service and associated equipment and installation services for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012;

WHEREAS, the Rate Filing has been placed in the public file and has been made available for public inspection, upon request; and

WHEREAS, the Office reviewed the Rate Filing and concluded that the Company's maximum permitted basic service rate, equipment rates, and installation rates appeared to be reasonable under the FCC Rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. As of October 1, 2011 (the effective date of the Rate Filings), the approved rates per month (excluding franchise fees) for basic service and associated equipment and installation are as follows:



The Company may not increase the rates for basic service, equipment or installation listed in Ordering Clause No. 1, nor may the Company institute new charges for other types of service, equipment or installation associated with basic service, equipment or installation which are not listed in said Ordering Clause, without first complying with applicable law or regulation, including the FCC Rules.
3. The rate card published by the Company and made available to subscribers shall at all times contain all rates, terms and conditions actually in effect for basic service and associated equipment and installation, provided that the Company may have short term promotions and discounts as permitted by applicable law.
4. If the Office determines that information the Company provided to the Office is incorrect in any material manner, the Office reserves the right to modify this Rate Order.

5. The Office shall mail a copy of this Rate Order to the Company, provide appropriate public notice of this Order, and make a copy of this Order available to any person upon request.
6. This Rate Order shall become effective this 28th day of November 2011.
